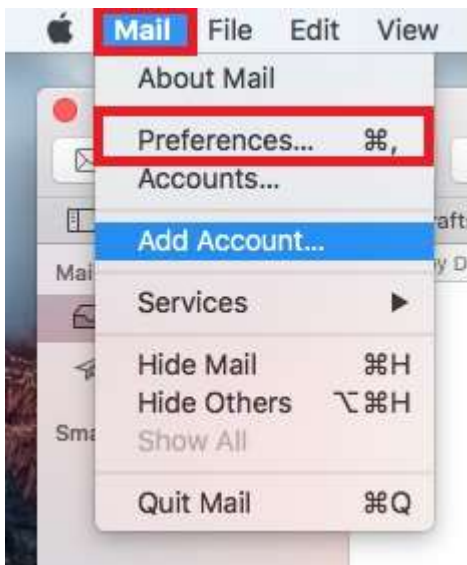


## Set up Truemail account for Mac OS X 10.11

1. Open Mail program, click stamp icon at Dock Bar below

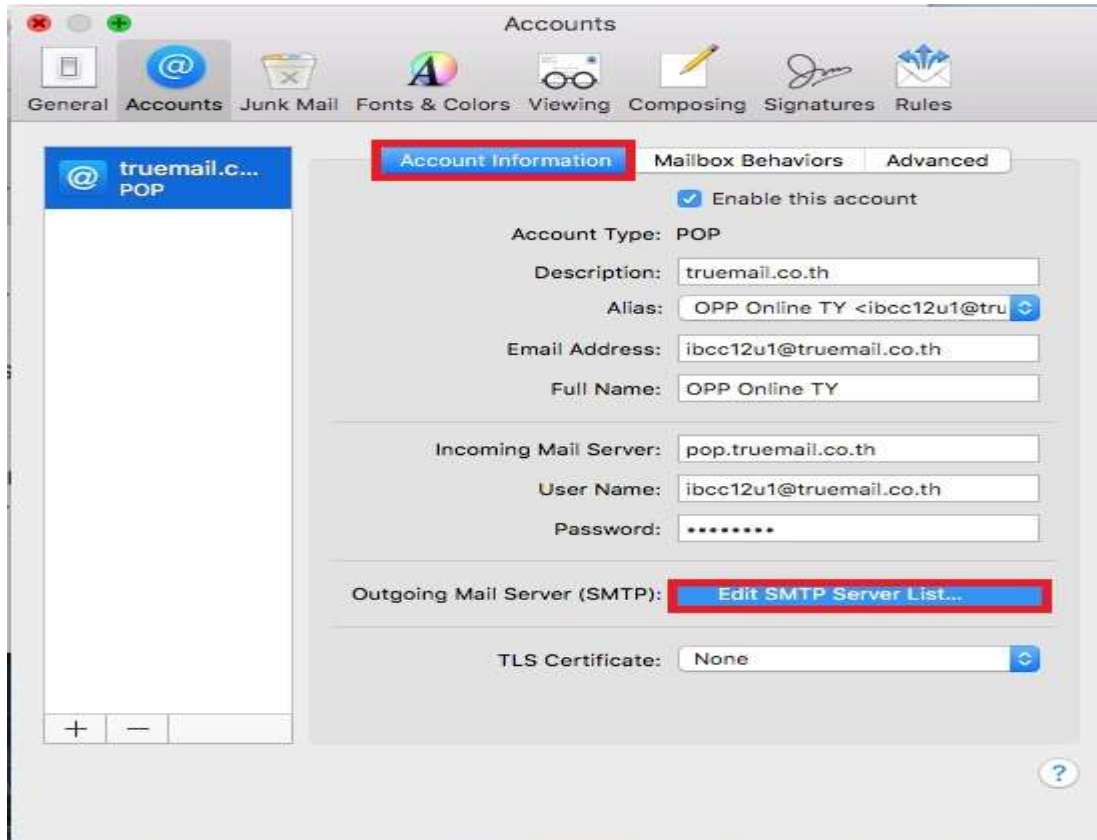


2. Click left tap menu, select Mail > Preference...



### 3. Set up Account Information as follows:

- Place a check mark at Enable this account
- Account Type: Mail Server type for first setting
- Description : Account Mail
- Alias: Account name <Email name> automatically appear
- Email Address: Account Email Truemail
- Full Name: sent mail name will be displayed at destination
- Incoming Mail Server: pop.truemail.co.th
- User Name: Account Email Truemail
- Password: enter Account Email Truemail
- Outgoing Mail Server (SMTP): select **Edit SMTP Server list...** to check for more settings



4. Once selected 'Edit SMTP Server list', then choose Account

- Description: Outgoing Server description
- Server Name: mxauth.truemail.co.th
- TLS Certificate: None (for truemail)



5. Once selected 'Edit SMTP Server list', then choose Advanced and check the settings:

- Place a check mark at Automatically detect and maintain account settings
- Port: 25
- Use SSL: uncheck
- Authentication: select Password
- Tick a check mark at Allow insecure authentication
- User Name: Truemail account
- Password: Truemail's password
- Press OK to back to main page
