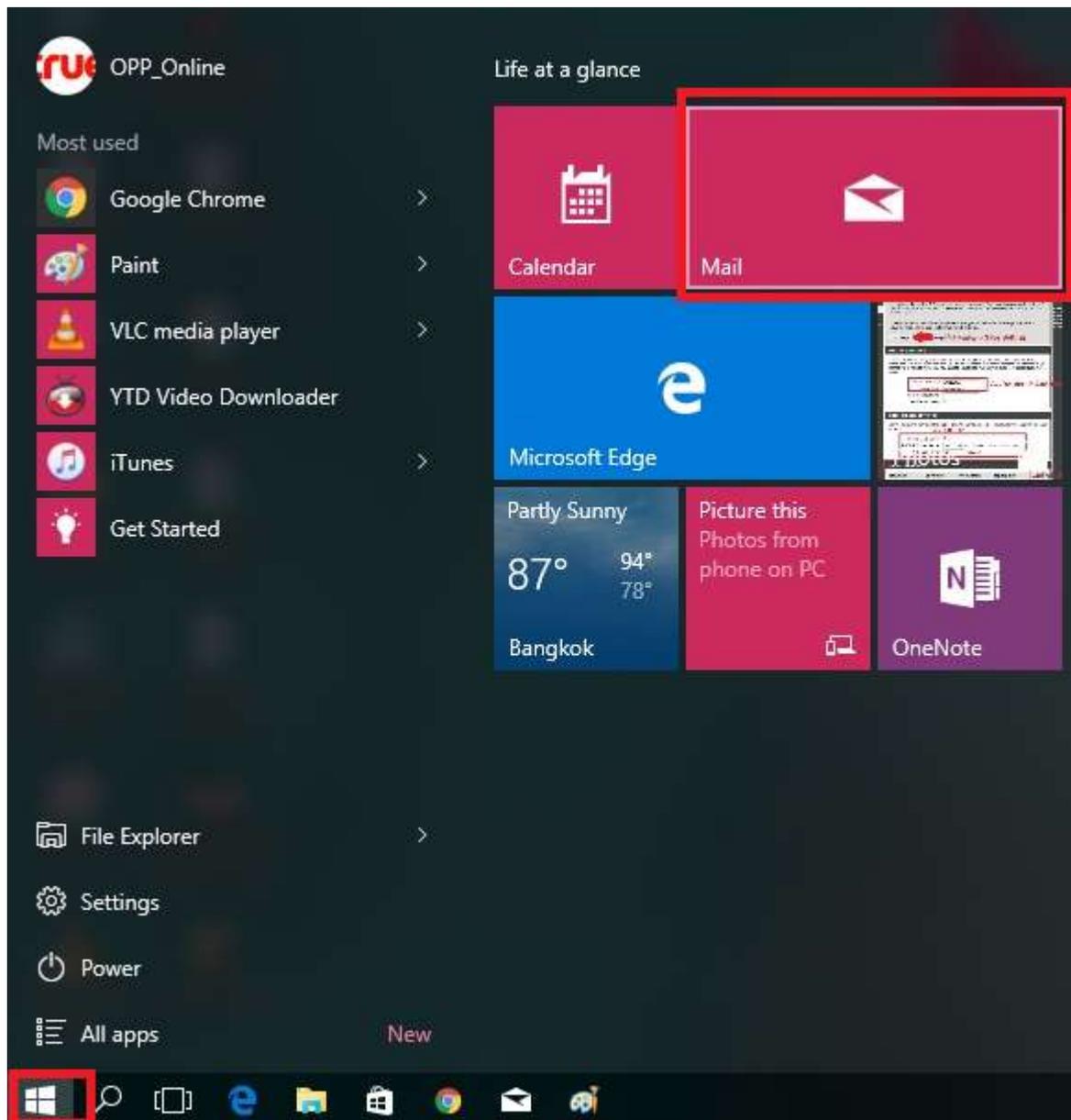
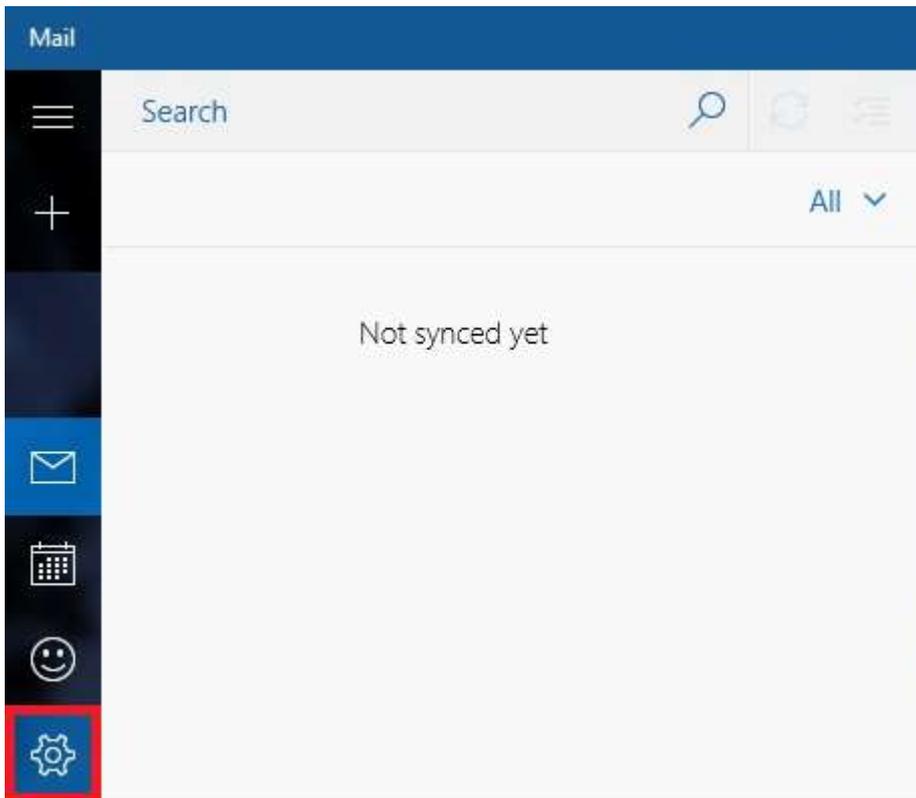


## Manually create Truemail Account on Windows 10

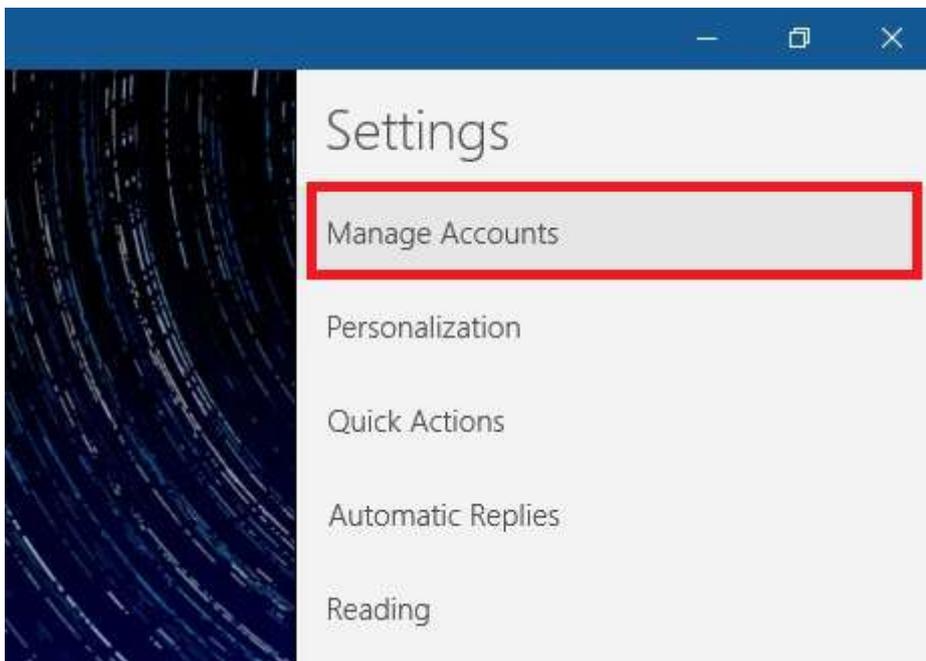
1. At Home screen, click Windows icon (bottom left) and select Mail



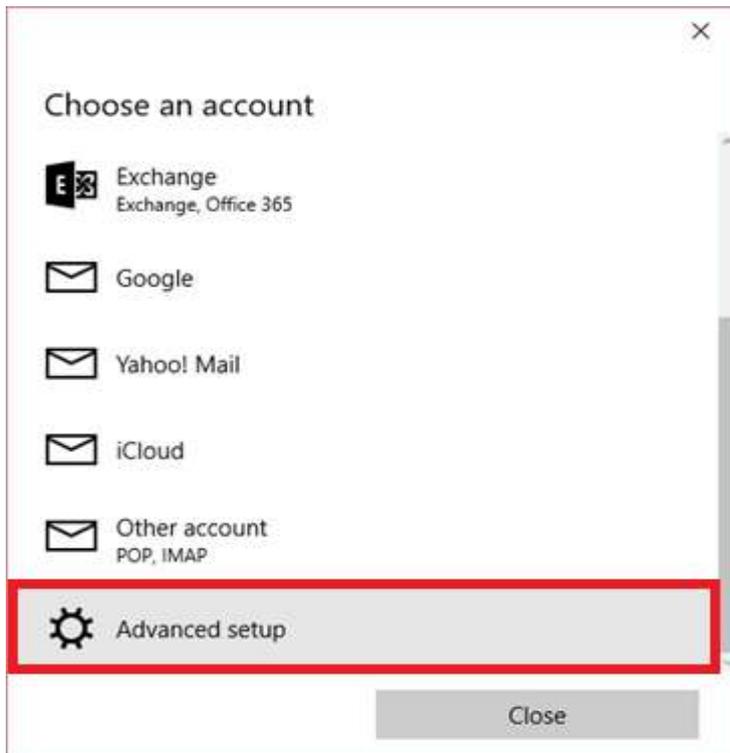
2. At Mail page, select gear sign (bottom left)



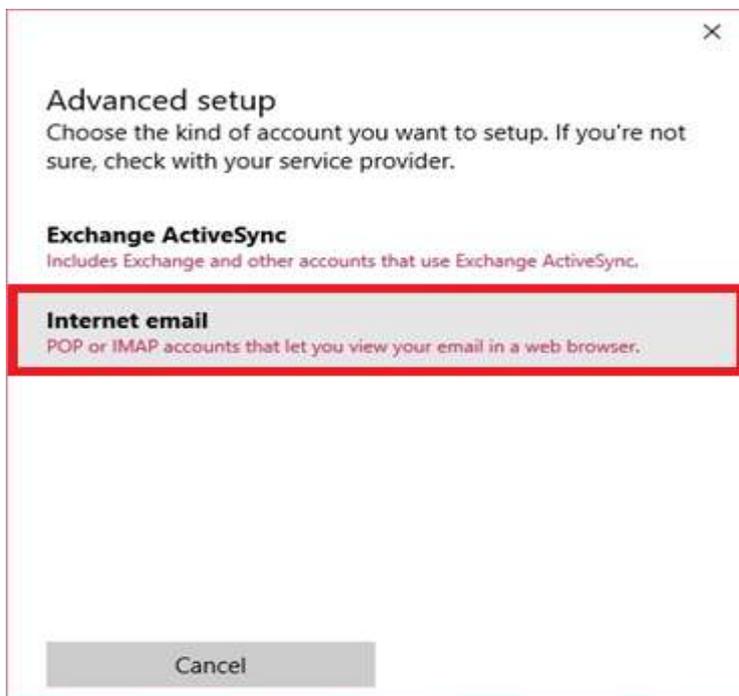
3. Settings → Manage Accounts

5. Select Internet email



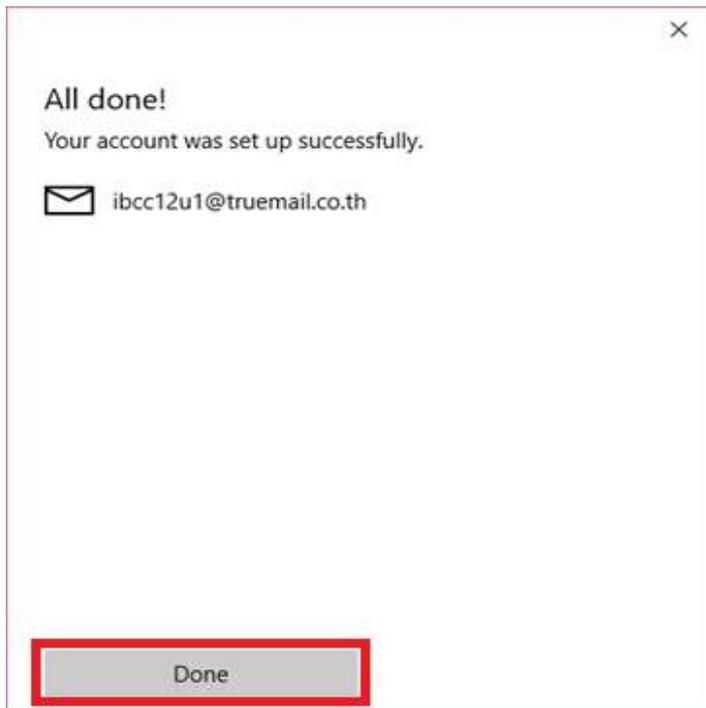
## 6. At Internet email account, enter following information:

- Require SSL for outgoing email : (remove a check mark)
- Press Sign in
