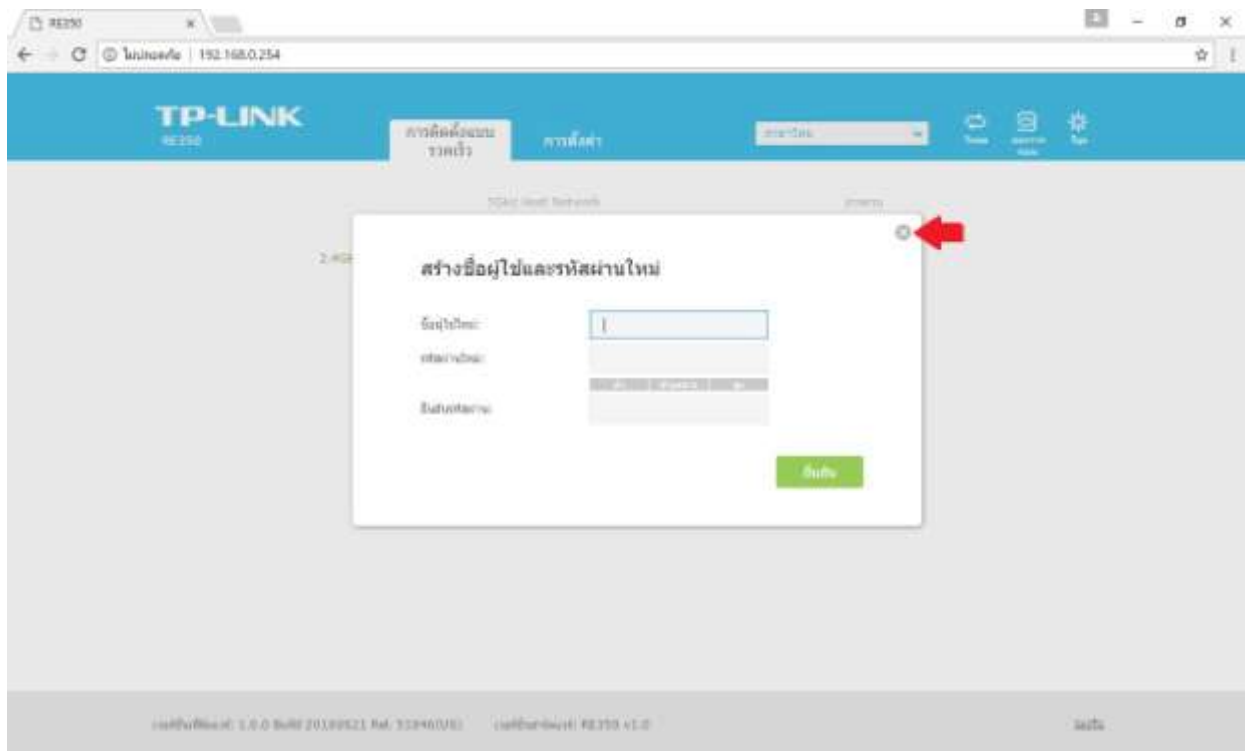


## Set up Access Point Mode for TP-Link RE350

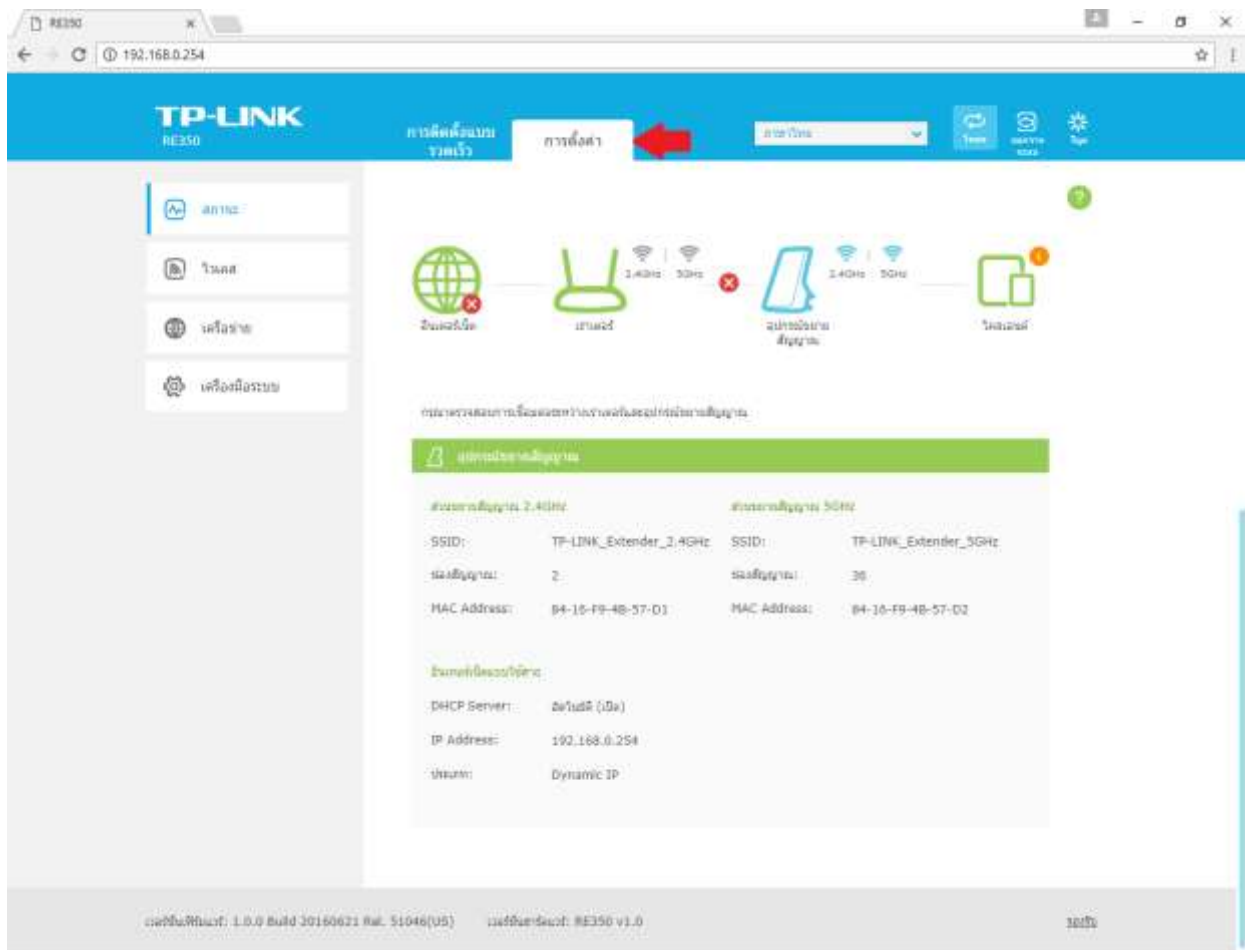
1. Type **http://tplinkrepeater.net** or **192.168.0.254** on Browser, enter Username = **admin** / Password = **admin** and press **Login**



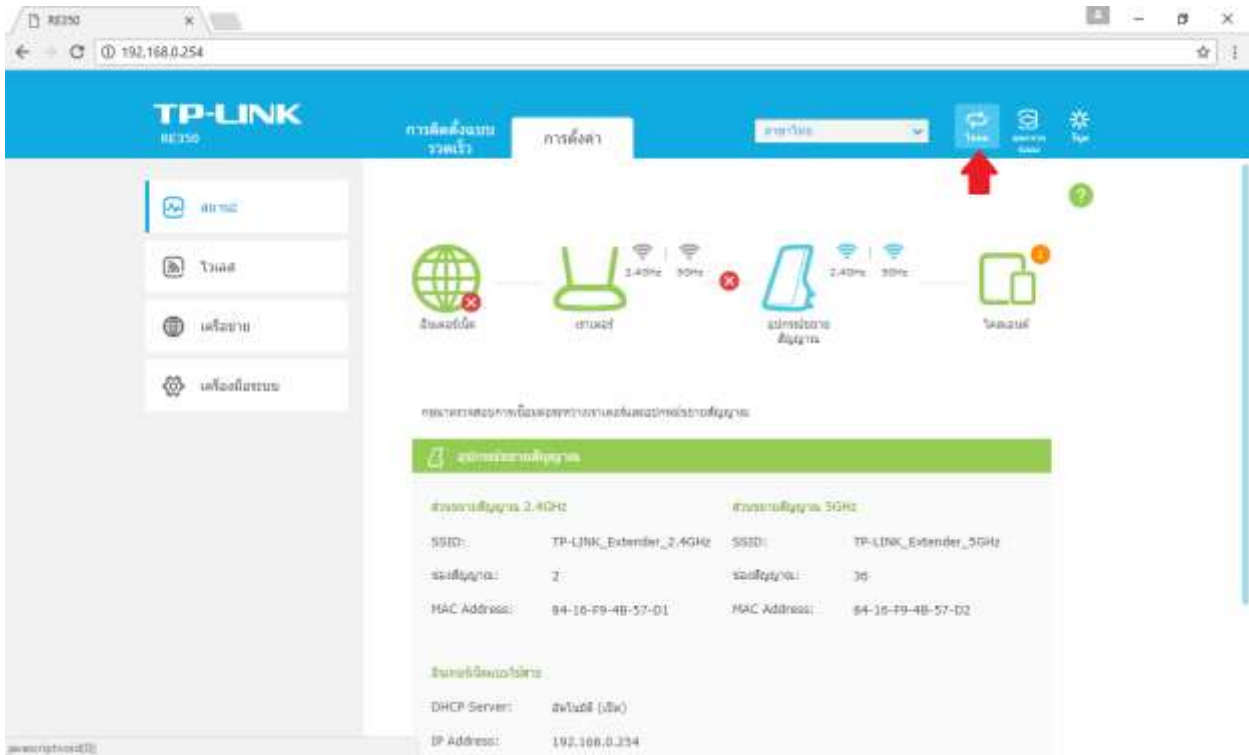
2. A pop up to Create a new username and password, if don't want to, click a Plus sign (x) to close this window



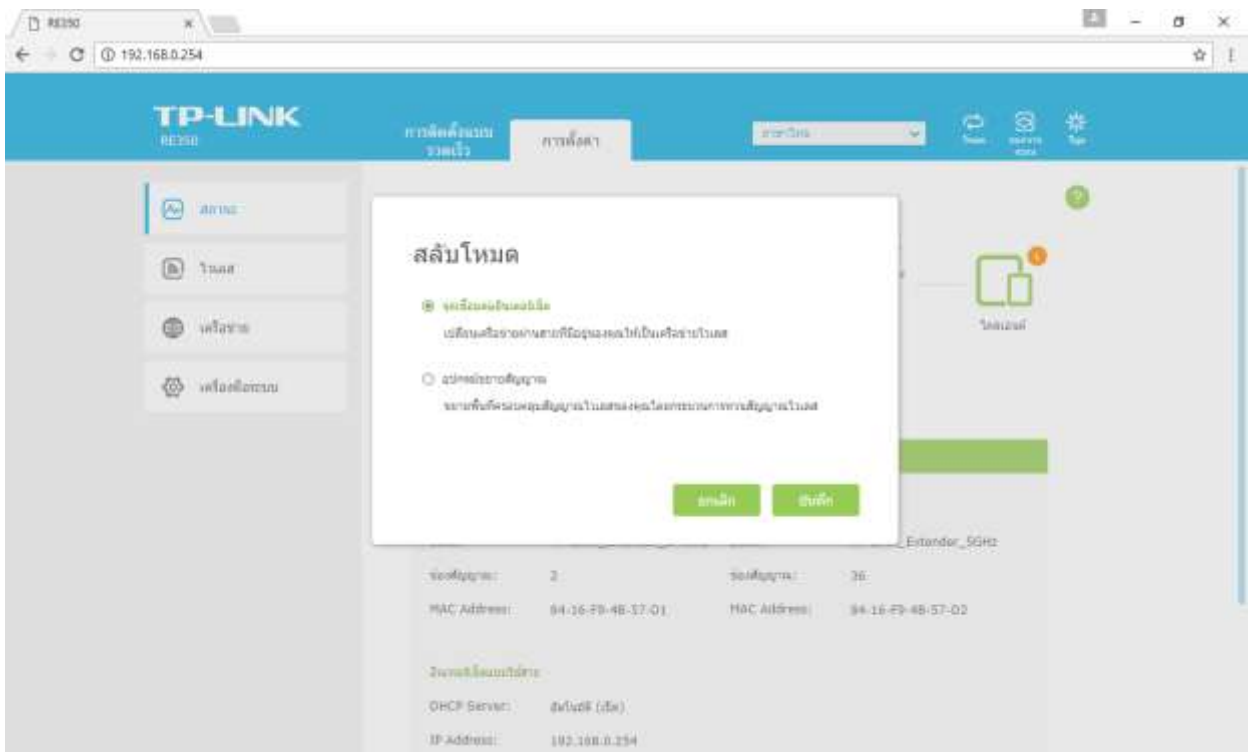
3. On the top menu, select **Settings**



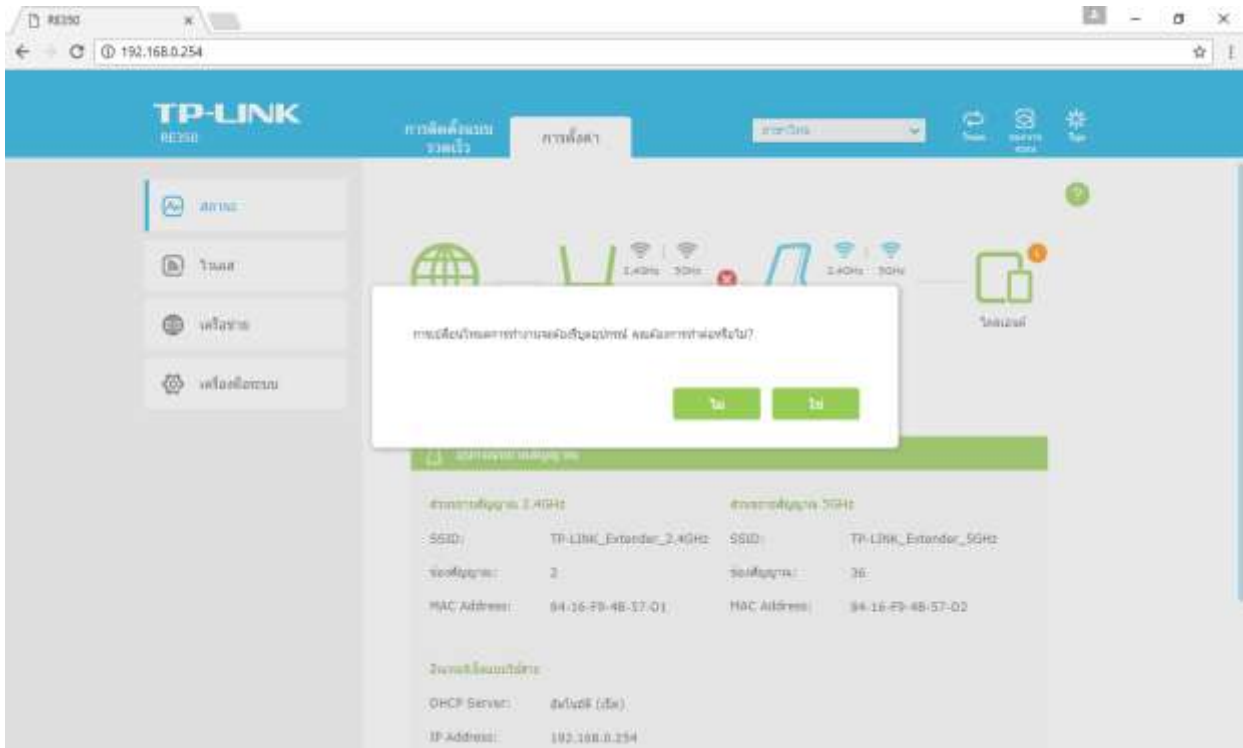
4. And choose **Mode**



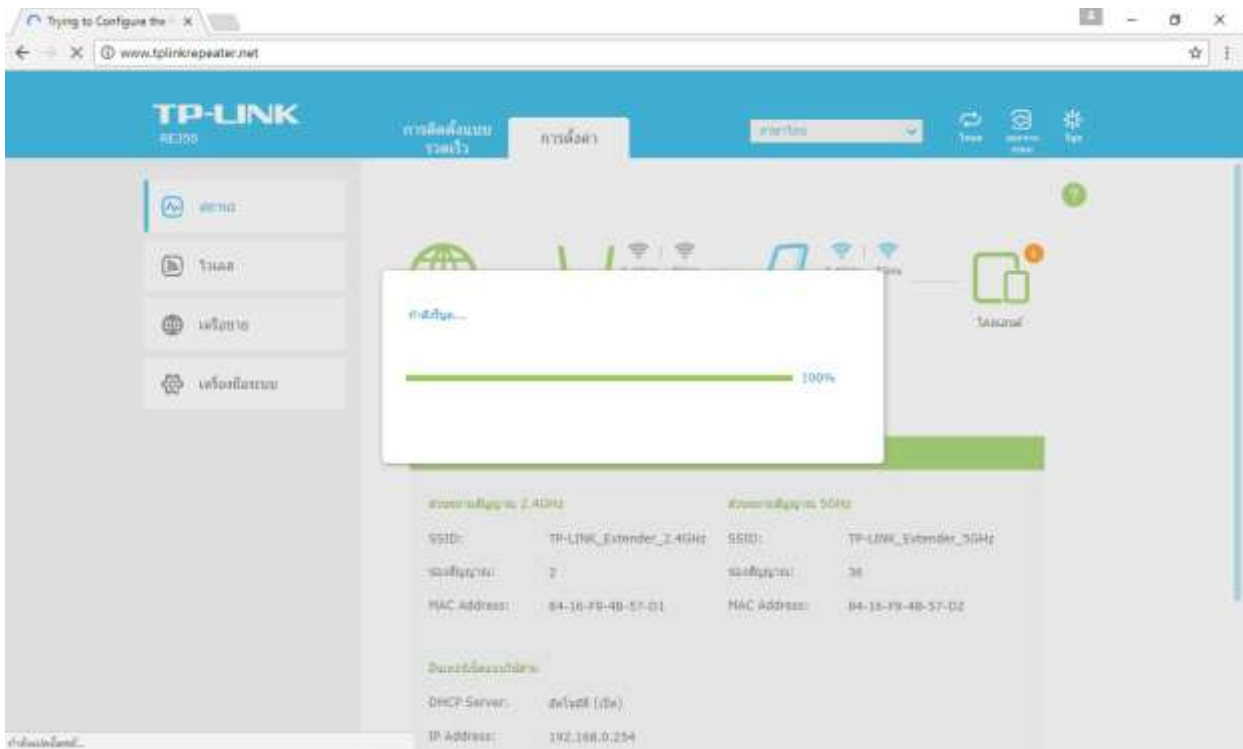
5. A pop up to Switch Mode, select **Internet Access Point** and press **Save**



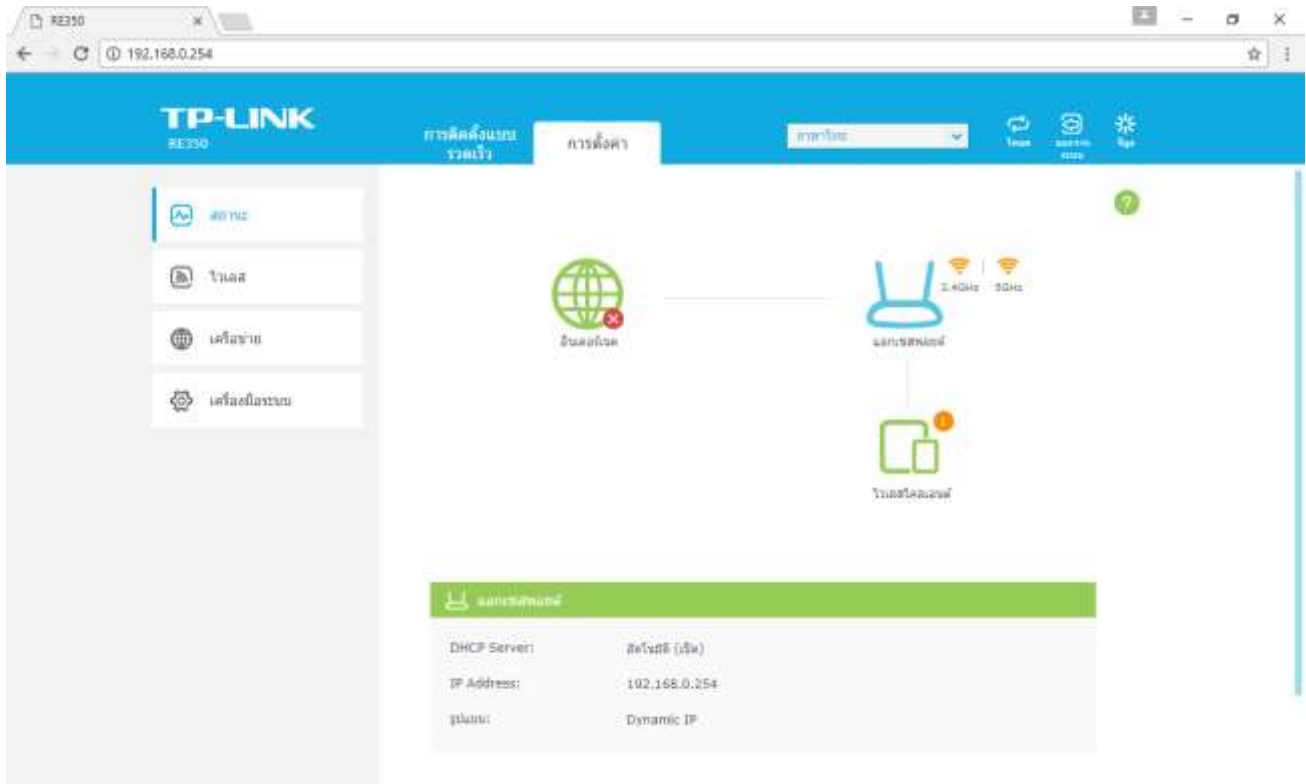
6. Press Yes again to confirm



7. The device is rebooting, wait for a while until 100%

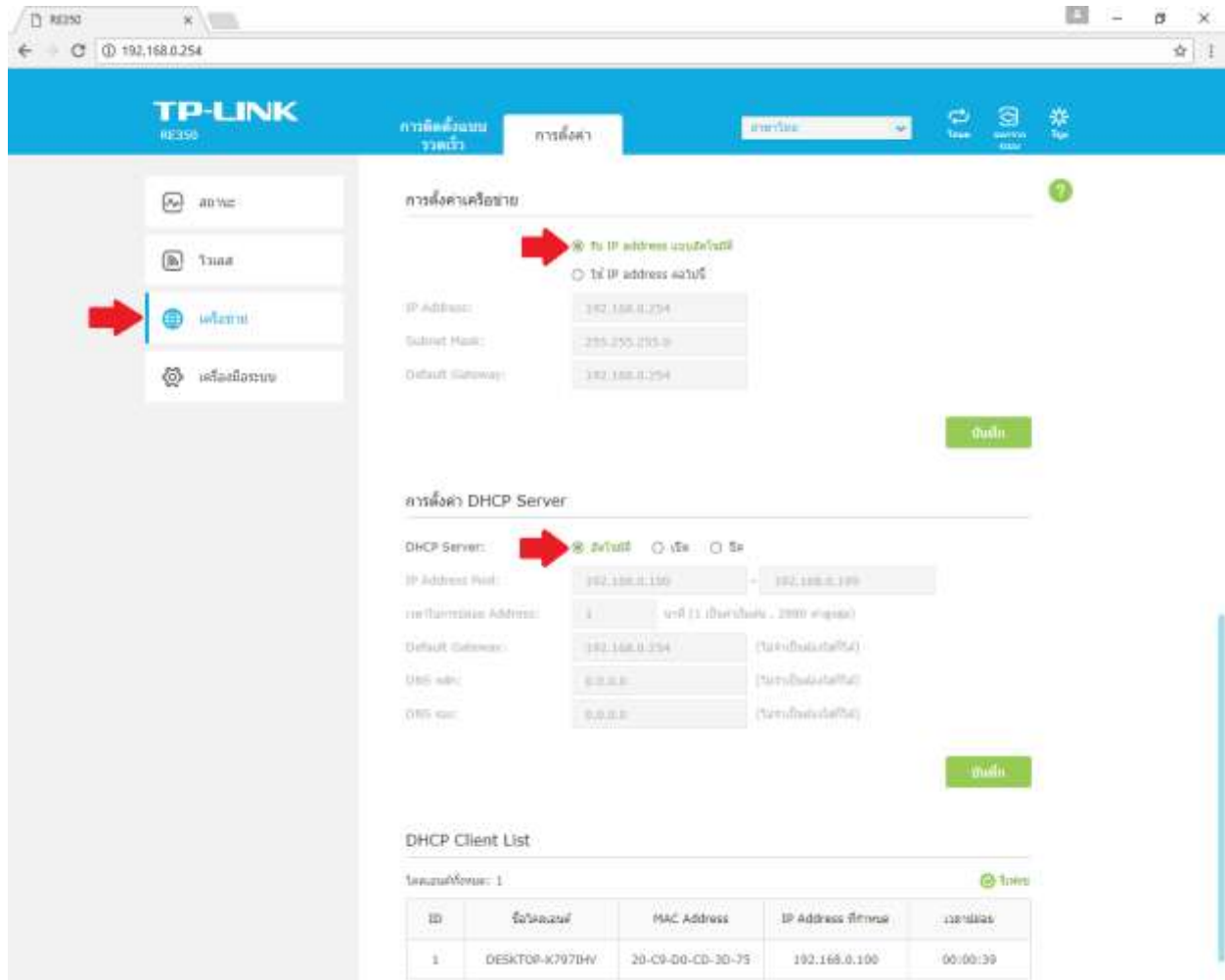


8. Back to Status page again

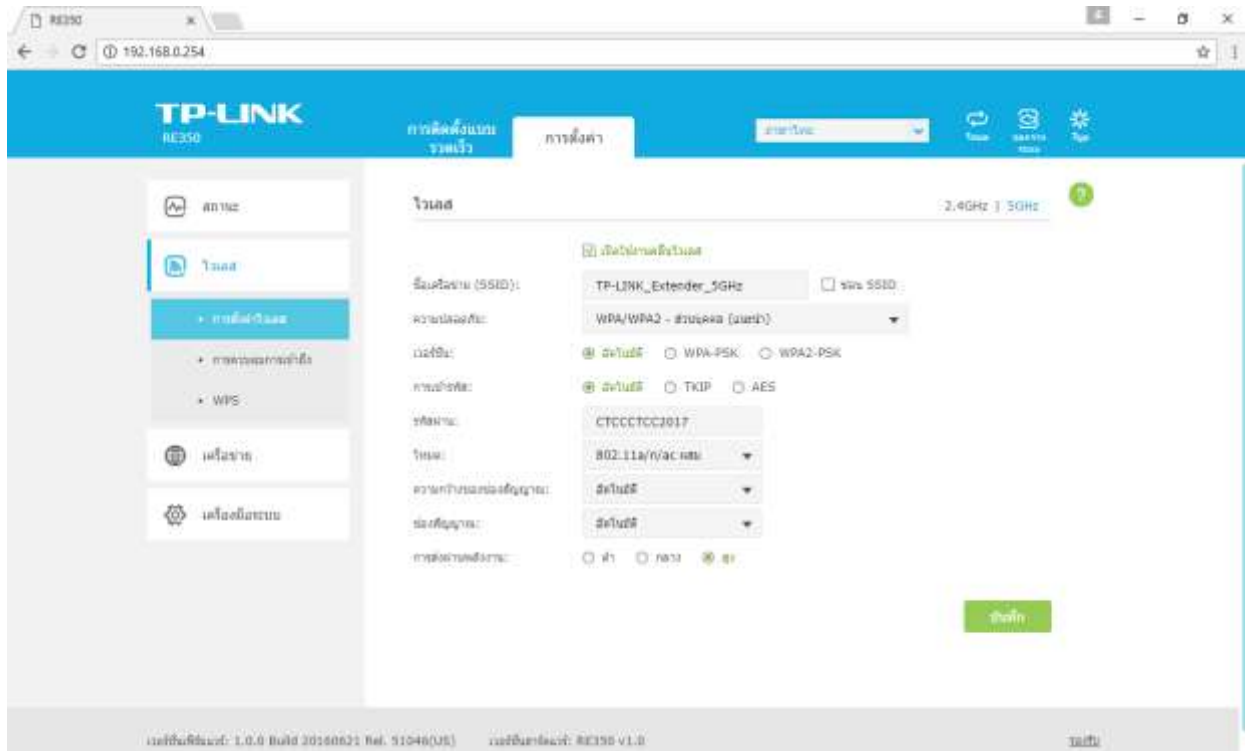


9. At **Settings** page, on the left menu, select **Network**

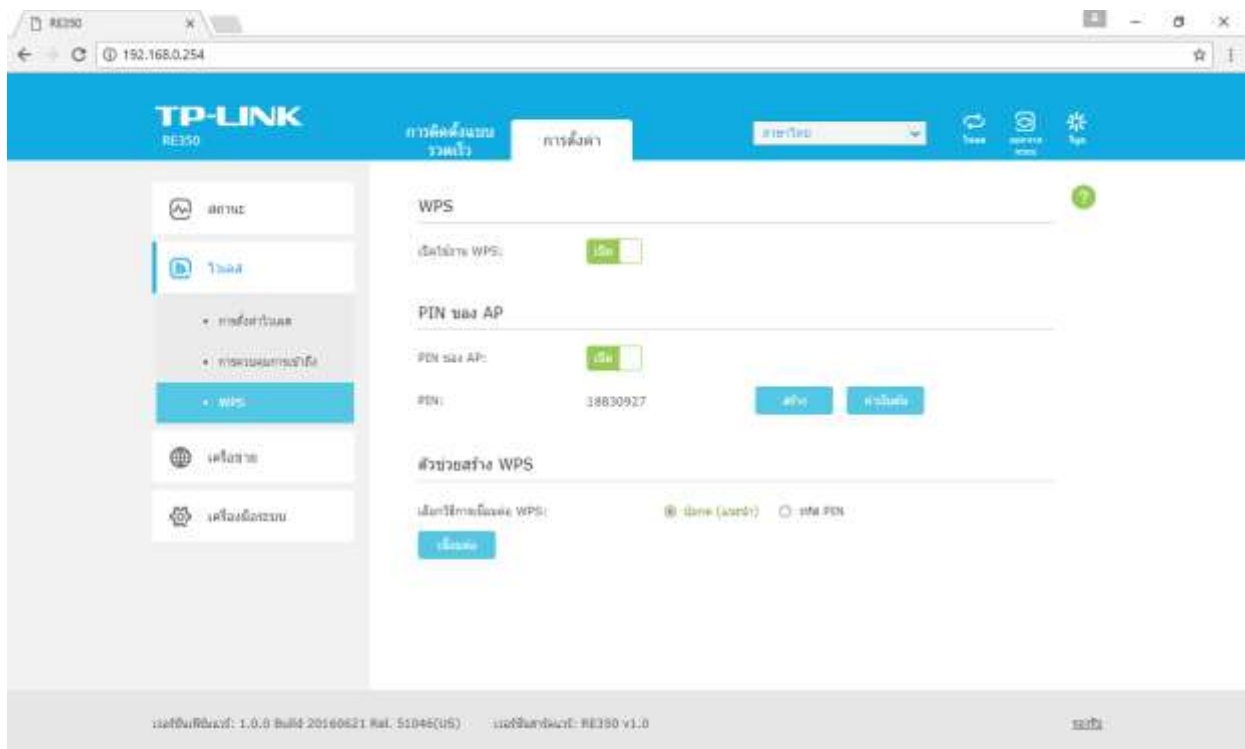
- Choose **Obtain an IP address automatically**, press **Save**

10. On the left menu, select **Wireless** and set up Wireless as desired

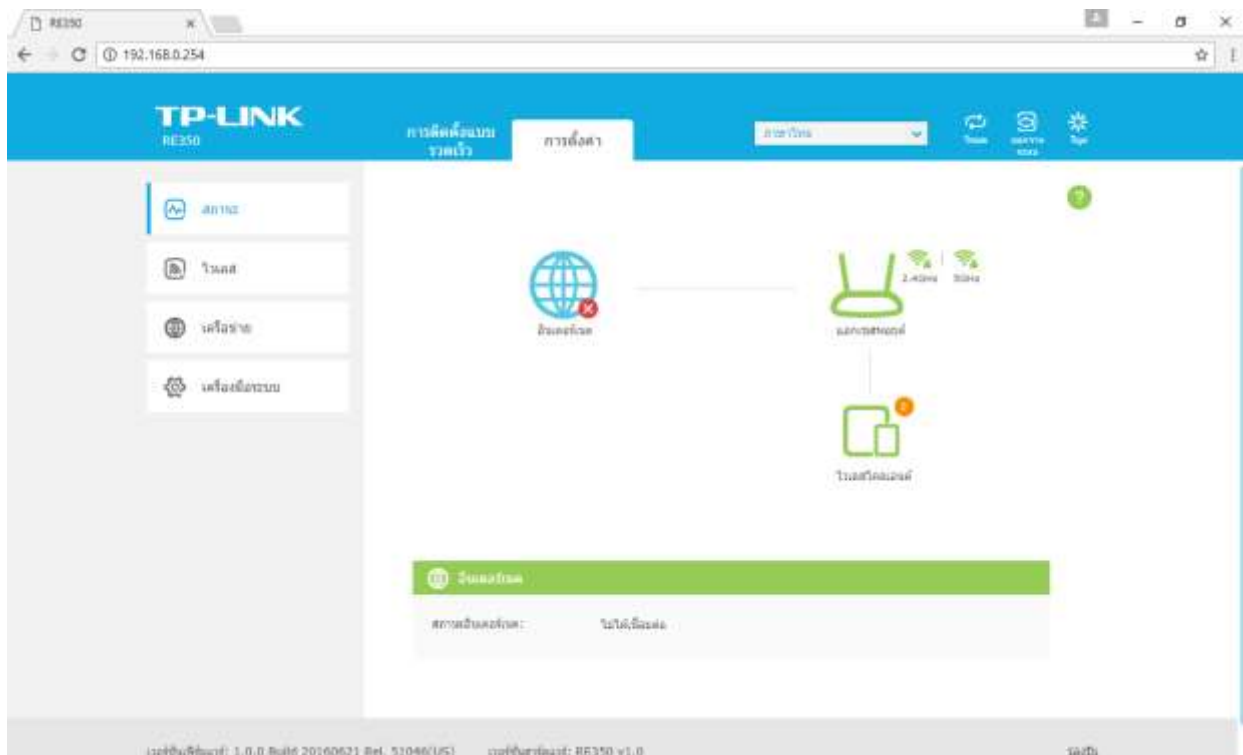


11. **WPS** : can set or not set

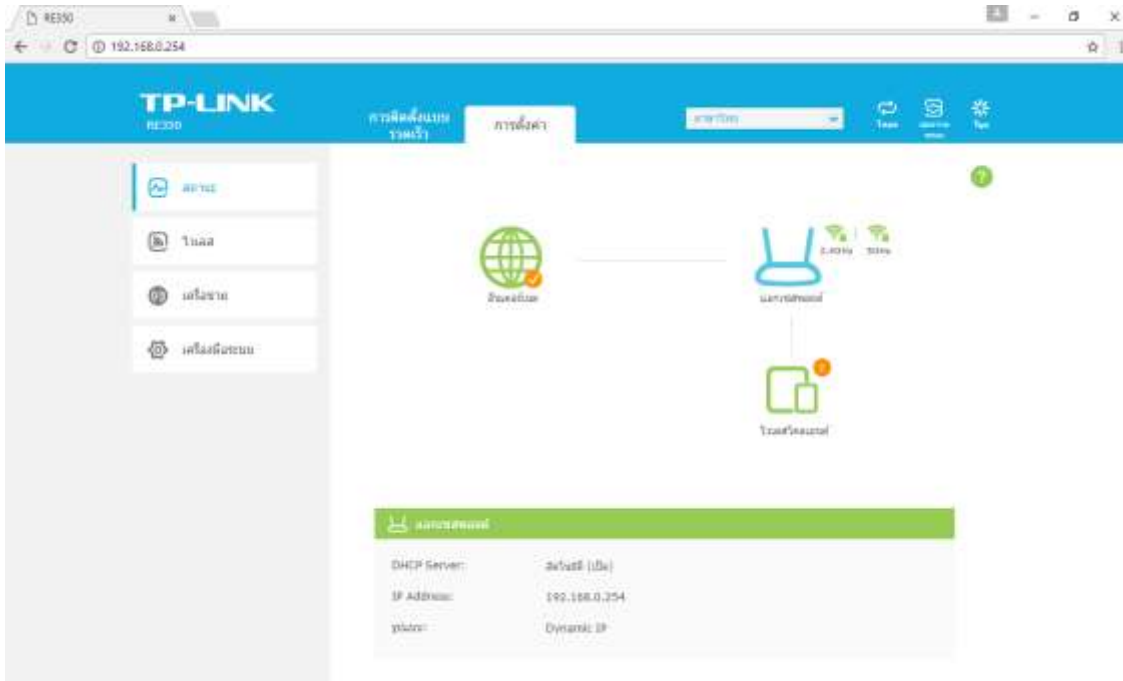




12. **Status menu** : if the customer doesn't connect LAN cable from main Router to Access Point, Internet status will show **"disconnect"**
