


Use Wi-Fi on Motorola moto g6 PLUS

This setting can apply to Motorola phone with Android 8.0 or latest

1. On main screen, tap (All App)




2. Select (Settings)





3. And then (Network&internet)




4. Select WiFi






5. Tap a button to turn on Wi-Fi




6. Once turned on, device will search for nearby Wi-Fi network and display on screen






7. Select preferred Wi-Fi ex. choose .@TRUEWIFI

- Once connected .@ TRUEWIFI will appear and a popup message to log in, tap it to proceed

- 10. A web Browser will automatically appear including a (SIGN IN TO WI-FI NETWORK) page of truemoveh






Enter Username – Password and then tap
(LOGIN)




12. After completely log in, it'll return to WIFI page and .@ TRUEWIFI shows Connected status > internet is ready to use





- 13. To check WiFi connection status, tap WiFi 14. That Wi-Fi information will appear e.g. IP name that you want to check (.@TRUEWIFI)
 - address, strength, band etc.


