

Share Internet via Wi-Fi Hotspot on Motorola moto g6 PLUS

This setting can apply to Motorola phone with Android 8.0 or latest

1. On main screen, tap (All App) sign



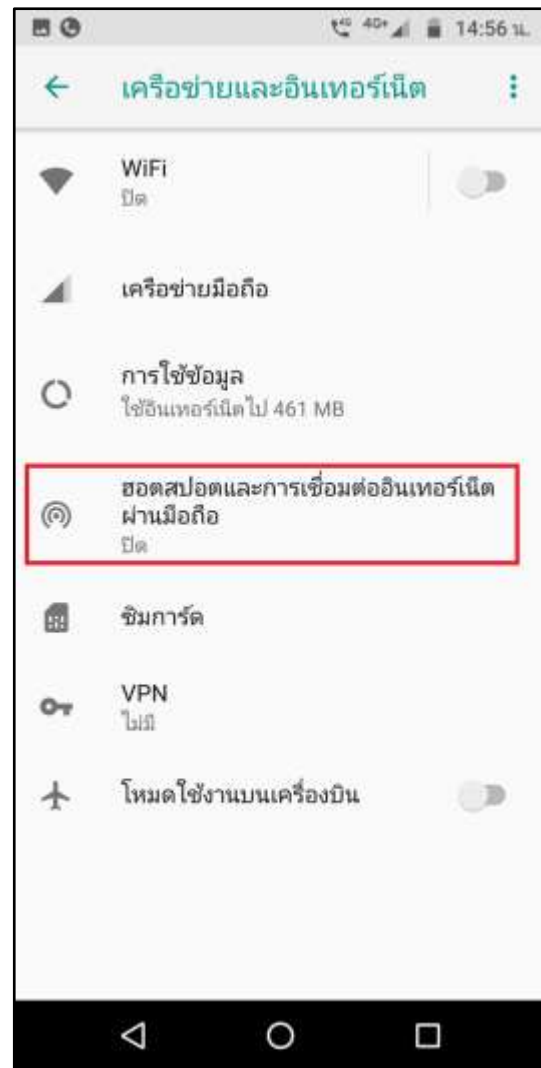
2. Select (Settings)



3. And then (Network & Internet)



4. Select (Hotspot & tethering)



5. For first use, choose (Set up Wi-Fi hotspot)



6. Set up Wi-Fi hotspot page

- Network name = can tap to change name
- Hide my device = tick a check if want to hide device name
- Security
 - None = not set
 - WPA2 PSK = set the password (contains at least 8 characters)
- Password = Wi-Fi password (if select WPA2 PSK)
- Show password = tick a check to see what is the password
- Select AP Band = seeselect band between 2.4 GHz and 5 GHz
- Tap (SAVE)



7. Back to (Hotspot & tethering), tap turn on (Portable Wi-Fi hotspot)



8. On screen it'll show the hotspot sign



remarks : when there's device connected to moto's WiFi Hotspot, there's no notification and unable to block that device (test with DEMO device), if it's customer's device, test this function first before informing the customer
